

Five things to do with your Word list

- 1 Write translations into your own language.
- 2 Keep a vocabulary notebook. After each unit, test yourself by making sentences using verbs and nouns from the Word list, for example in Unit 1:
 - During the **briefing**, I'll **find out** the schedule for the flight. The purser **is looking forward to** working with new **colleagues**.
- 3 Check each verb in your dictionary. If it has a noun form, write it down, for example in Unit 4: pay / payment recommend / recommendation
- 4 Look up words in an English-English dictionary. Find meanings and synonyms (words with a similar meaning). For every word you look up, learn two new ones.
- 5 In your vocabulary notebook, write down words from anywhere in the Word list under useful headings, for example: Crew
 Passengers
 Safety
 Service
